The software module consists of a webbased database in which relevant installations, metering devices -including their accuracy-, monthly CO<sub>2</sub> emission data (activity data) and associated tiers are stored.

Because the software generates automated emission reports, verification can be done at lower costs. In addition, the module provides monthly management information about the company's position, making it easy for executives to decide whether to take on-site reduction measures, buy CO₂ credits or sell superfluous credits.
